WHEN I TRAVEL, I PLEDGE THAT I WILL:

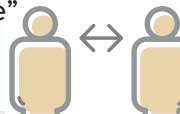


REMAIN INFORMED and adhere to CDC suggestions and government restrictions when traveling domestically and abroad
