My personal favorites have always been four-wheel-drive, off-road vehicles like Land Rovers because their aluminum bodies don't rust, their four-wheel diff locks are superior and they're made of individual body panels, which make them easy to customize.

We make dozens of changes to every vehicle including lengthened frames, specialized seats for comfort, engine snorkels for river crossings, shock absorbers, charging outlets, and pop-up roofs for 360° views and sun protection – to name a few.

Thomson's vehicle modifications make such a difference from a passenger's point of view—wow! Compared to any other safari vehicles out there, the visibility towards the horizon from any of the seats is unsurpassed.



RESPONSIBLE TOURISM

Travel is one of life's greatest joys. It inspires and teaches us, and it makes us better citizens of the world. That's why in 1997, Judi Wineland and a group of Thomson guests founded our sister non-profit, Focus on Tanzanian Communities (FOTZC), which brings tourism dollars to impoverished areas.

FOTZC has spent more than \$3.4 million drilling wells, building health facilities and classrooms, and helping women start sustainable, profitable businesses in Tanzania.

CLEAN WATER

A clean, accessible water source is at the core of every healthy community. FOTZC boreholes provide water to several thousand people in Tanzania, virtually eradicating waterborne diseases.

HEALTH CARE

For people in the Sukenya area, walking 12 miles to get heath care was the only option until FOTZC built a small health dispensary there. Due to its success, it has expanded its services to a health center providing basic medical services, including immunizations and family planning classes.

In 2023, 485 babies were delivered and over 19,000 patients received health care services.

EDUCATION

Children in Tanzania have been at the center of FOTZC's mission since its very foundation, when a visit to a broken-down schoolroom sparked the idea for this non-profit.

FOTZC has built 60 classrooms, provided housing for over 40 teachers and built dorms for hundreds of students, expanding opportunities for over 29,000 children.

WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT

Women in Tanzania wanted opportunities to run businesses and provide for their families independently. That's why FOTZC launched a microfinance program that helps women start small, environmentally friendly businesses.

Since 2015, FOTZC has helped over 400 women start businesses in beekeeping, leather tanning, beading and other sustainable, profitable enterprises.





RUAHA

TANZANIA'S LARGEST, MOST REMOTE NATIONAL PARK
