

## Rwanda - Volcanoes Pre Ext. (5.2)

## YOUR ITINERARY

## Day 1 Arrive to Kigali, Rwanda

Today you will meet your guide and transfer to your hotel in downtown Kigali, Rwanda.

### Transfer Upon Arrival in Kigali

A Volcanoes Safaris representative will meet you at the airport and transfer you to your hotel.

Accommodations: Kigali Serena Hotel

### Day 2 Rwanda

After breakfast, your guide will drive you to the base of the Sabinyo Mountains, to the town of Kinigi, about 3 hours away from Kigali.

#### Kigali Tour

Take a tour of Kigali with your guide.

#### Visit Rwanda Genocide Memorial

While in the city of Kigali, visit the Rwandan Genocide Memorial, where you can peruse the interior exhibits as well as the beautiful memorial gardens.

#### Lunch in Kigali

En route through Kigali, you will stop for lunch in the city.

### Transfer to the Virunga Volcanoes

After lunch, you will head on a three hour journey across Rwanda's rolling green hills and farmland up to the Virunga Volcanoes where, on clear days, you can see up to five volcanic peaks. Settle into your rooms at the lodge where you can relax for the afternoon.

#### Day 3 **Rwanda**

The Parc des Volcans protects the steep slopes of the Virunga mountains - home of the rare mountain gorilla - and a rich mosaic of montane ecosystems nearby.

#### Briefing on Gorilla Tracking Etiquette

Before you set foot on the trail, your guide will brief you on what to expect and how to behave in the presence of the gorillas. As they are an extremely rare species living in a fragile environment, it is extraordinarily important for you to observe some simple rules. Please note that anyone suffering from cold or flu symptoms, or any other infectious conditions will not be permitted on the trek.

#### Gorilla Trek

With your guide leading the way, explore the lush, dense forest in search of gorillas. Trekking conditions may be strenuous, so please be prepared with the proper equipment provided in your packing list. Once you find the gorillas, you will spend a maximum of one hour in their presence, during which any thoughts of strenuous hiking will be forgotten!

### Day 4 Rwanda

Rwanda offers challenging trekking for any reasonably fit traveler. Lush jungle trails can be steep, but the experience of seeing gorillas in the wild will be well worth the effort.

#### Second Gorilla Trek

Take another excursion into the forest with your guide to look for gorillas. Trekking times may vary from as little as one hour to as long as six hours, if the gorillas are roaming a particularly remote corner of the mountains. It is highly probable that you will see gorillas on one or more trekking days, but due to the wild and unpredictable nature of such an endeavor, gorilla sightings cannot be guaranteed.

#### Lunch at the Lodge

Enjoy lunch at the lodge. You will also have a chance to shower and repack before your departure this afternoon.

#### Transfer back to Kigali

Your guide will drive you back to the city of Kigali at the end of your Rwandan adventure.
